

## First-Time Student Packing List - Big Sky Encampment - Montana Wing

- ❑ 1x Complete Blues Uniform (IAW CAPR 39-1):
  - 1x Blues pants/skirt
  - 1x Short-sleeve blues shirt
  - 1x Blues belt with chrome tip
  - 1x Flight cap with hat device insignia
  - 1x Pair of black low-quarter shoes or pumps
  - 2x Pairs black dress socks
  - 1x set of badges and nametag (**Ribbons optional**)
  - Optional: shirt stays/garters
  - 2x White V-Neck undershirts (**no crew neck**)
- ❑ 2x Complete ABU Uniform (IAW CAPR 39-1)
  - 2x ABU blouses with sewn-on CAP/nametapes (**3x recommended**)
  - 2x ABU trousers (**3x recommended**)
  - 1x ABU belt with black open-face buckle
  - 1x ABU patrol cap
  - 5x Desert tan t-shirts (**plain or CAP-related only**)
  - 6x pairs black boot socks
  - 1x pair of black combat boots (**Broken In!**)
  - 2x pairs of rank insignia (**4 total**)
- ❑ 3x Physical Training (PT) Uniforms
  - 3x pairs black/navy blue athletic shorts (**NO writing, small logos acceptable, shorts must be appropriate for physical activity**)
  - 3x plain black t-shirts
  - 6x pairs white, grey, navy blue or black athletic socks (**plain**)
  - 1x pairs athletic shoes (**should be comfortable to run in**)
- ❑ Hygiene Items:
  - 1x pair shower shoes
  - 1x bar of soap in container or bottle of body wash
  - 1x bottle of shampoo
  - 1x Deodorant
  - 1x Toothbrush and toothpaste
  - 1x Shaving kit (razor and cream)
  - 1x Comb/brush
  - 1x Hair ties and accessories (females)
  - 1x Feminine hygiene products (females)
  - 1x personal care kit including foot powder, moleskin, and Band-Aids
  - 1x Sunscreen and Insect Repellent
  - 1x Bath Towel and washcloth
- ❑ Duty Items:
  - 1x CAPID card with CAPF161 in pocket
  - 3x pens (black or blue ink)
  - 1x black permanent marker
  - 1x shoe shining kit (NO liquid polish allowed)
  - 1x poncho
  - 1x 18-inch ruler
- ❑ Other clothing items:
  - Pillow
  - 8x pairs of underwear
  - 4x bras (**females**)
  - 4x coat hangers
  - Optional: lint roller, extra insignia, sewing kit, nail clippers, glasses strap, swimsuit if uncomfortable with open showers

### Prohibited Items:

- Blades of any kind (knives, etc.) (Sewing scissors under 2in are permitted)
- Electronics (gaming, cellphones, tablets, smart watches)
- Weapons
- Illegal drugs (prescription and non-prescription must be disclosed)
- Tobacco or Alcohol products of any kind including alcohol mouthwash
- Drinks, food, candy, gum, supplements
- Jewelry (other than 1 set of earring studs for females)
- Only pack what is on the list! Anything outside the list will be considered contraband and confiscated for the duration of the Encampment

Do not leave home without verifying the entire packing list is included and make sure everything is packed neatly so that you will be able to carry them in and out of the vehicle without leaving anything, i.e. tie shoes to duffle bags, etc.

It is the member's responsibility to make sure all items are labeled clearly with their Name and CAPID. Any found items that do not have a label will be given to the first to claim it with no attempt to negotiate ownership. Cadets are responsible for keeping their items in their area of the barracks/bags to prevent confusion and accidental transfers of ownership.

**Items that are provided: PT T-Shirts, Sleeping Linens/Blankets, Canteens, and PT Belts.**
