4 White V-NECK T-Shirts	Any Prescribed Medications (MUST BE ON CAPF160)
1 AF Blue belt with SILVER buckle	Shower shoes (flip-flop sandals/slides)
1 Pr Low Quarter shoes (WELL BROKEN IN) (leather preferred)	2 Towels and 1 washcloth - showers are required daily
4 Pr Black Dress Socks MUST BE BLACK	Swimwear mandatory
1 Service Coat with appropriate attachments (preferred, not required)	Pain Reliever (MUST BE ON CAPF160) (NOT TO BE SHARED)
1 Tie or tie tab (appropriate to gender)	Wrist Watch
Non Uniform Clothing	Personal Preparation Checklist
7 Sets of Underwear	Fresh, regulation haircut & shave IAW CAPR 39-1
4 sets of plain black athletic shorts (must be a solid color with non-offensive printing)	Uniforms need to be clean, pressed, and inspection-ready
2 Sets of Long Sleeve Sweatshirts & Sweatpants - optional non-offensive printing. Solid colors: gray, black or blue only	Uniform Shoes/boots to be clean and highly polished
10 Pairs Athletic Socks (black preferred)	Individual First Aid Kit (IFAK): 1 Gallon Zip Lock Bag containing: 1 Moleskin or Lekutape, 3 bandaids, 3 steril gauze, 3 alcohol wipes, triple antibiotic ointment, 2 triangle bandages, 1 self adhesive wrap, 10 pairs of nitrile gloves, 1 package of hand wipes.

7 Bras (5 sports types) (Female)	
1 Pair of Running shoes (WELL BROKEN IN)	Sunglasses (budget pair incase of loss or damage)
Prohibited Items	
Knives	No food, candy, gum or snacks of any kind
Lighters, Matches, Fire Starters, Fireworks	No Beverages other than Water
Tobacco Products of any kind	Non-prescription drugs not listed on medical form
Cell Phones will be collected and secured for the duration	Books, magazines, reading materials. Religious documents (E.G. Bible) are authorized.
Electronics (I-pods, laptops, etc...)	Cash/Wallets will be confiscated to prevent theft

Members with food restrictions may bring food only after coordinating with the Advanced Cadet Commander

Do not leave home without verifying the entire packing list is included and make sure everything is packed neatly so that you will be able to carry them in and out of the vehicle without leaving anything (IE Tie shoes to duffles, ect)

No backpack or everyday carry bag will be needed, this will be provided.

It is the member's responsibility to make sure all items are labeled clearly with their name/CAPID. Any found items that do not have a label will be given to the first to claim it with no attempt to negotiate ownership. Cadets are responsible for keeping their items in their area of the barracks/bags to prevent confusion and accidental transfers of ownership.
